For several months COBWRA has been waging a heroic battle against the **GL Homes Proposal to Dismantle the Ag Reserve Master Plan**. GL Homes proposes to relocate density previously approved in northwest Palm Beach County to protected Ag Reserve land in West Boynton. COBWRA is joined by just about every local environmental group in our opposition to the proposal.

The GL Proposal represents an existential threat to the Ag Reserve. This is a “David vs. Goliath” battle against a powerful developer with unlimited financial resources. We have, therefore, decided to hire a respected attorney, Richard Grosso, to represent COBWRA on this issue going forward.
